Loren Lustig became a dedicated and lifelong conservationist as a young child growing up in northern Illinois. His daybreak fishing trips (with father and brother) were absolutely unforgettable. A major development in his life and career came when he was appointed as a Wildlife Biologist working with Dr. Vagn Flyger at the University of Maryland. After 5 years working with Dr. Flyger, Loren began his lifelong passion for Environmental Education. Loren met his wife, Louise, at a science learning center in the Black Hills of South Dakota and they now live on a farm north of Gettysburg. PA.

Loren has taken many steps to increase the number and type of squirrels living with him on his farm. This would include hanging nesting boxes, planting nut producing trees, and providing supplemental food (corn) during the winter time. The resident squirrels have fully reimbursed Mr. Lustig through their amazing acrobatic stunts and their fascinating interactions and antics.
