- Students, chaperones & teachers MUST stay together at all times.
- ° Trips are held RAIN or SHINE!

- Number of students LIMITED to a maximum of 70.
- Weekday Pre-K & Kindergarten programs are 1 hour in length at 10 AM, except for the Fall Harvest program, which is 2 hours in length.
- $^{\circ}\,$  All other  $\,$  school age groups are 2 hours in length at 10 AM to 12 PM.
- ° Teachers and chaperones are expected to be fully involved in the program and to provide student oversight.
- Please do not bring siblings as our indoor space is limited.
- ° We have picnic tables to eat your lunch. Bring bags & carry trash out with you.
